PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS AND APPROACHES

I. RESPONSIBILITY

- A. Section 5543.16 of the Ohio Revised Code provides: "The owners of land shall construct and keep in repair all approaches or driveways from the public roads, under the direction of the Board of Trustees of Perry Township."
- B. All material, labor, and equipment necessary for construction and proper maintenance of driveways and approaches shall be furnished by property owner at his expense.
- C. If at any time the culvert ceases to function properly, it may be removed by township forces in order to ensure proper highway drainage.
- D. If, during road and ditch maintenance operations, the Township destroys the approach or driveway of any abutting property owner, it will be reconstructed by the Township.

II. DESIGN REGULATIONS

- A. Maintain minimum grade and develop drive profile to generally conform to shoulder contour. Drive and approach to be constructed to avoid wash-out of loose surface material and so that no surface water will be drained onto Township road.
- B. Culvert for drive shall be laid to line and grade of adjacent roadside ditch or as specified by the Board of Trustees of said Township.
- C. Pipe size shall be a minimum of 12 inch diameter by 20 feet long of as specified by the Board of Trustees of said Township.
- D. Recommend Pipe: Double Wall Plastic
- E. Cover over pipe will vary according to individual conditions, however a minimum of 12" is recommended.
- F. Headwall design shall be approved by the Board of Trustees of said Township.
